



Dulux Study Tour – Terms and Conditions

1. Entry into the Dulux Study Tour 2012 is open to all architects and graduates of architecture of up to 10 years from graduation of the two-tier or five year Bachelor of Architecture degree (must have graduated between 2001- 2010 inclusive). However, it is only open to Australian citizens/residents and New Zealand citizens residing in Australia. It is not mandatory that entrants are Australian Institute of Architects members.

2. Non-winning entrants from previous years are welcome to re-enter, subject to meeting the eligibility criteria.

3. Nominees must be nominated by their employer for 'outstanding contribution' to architecture/architectural practice and/or a main project completed within the last two years. The nominating employer must be a financial Australian Institute of Architects member. Self nominations are permitted for self employed nominees, who are financial Australian Institute of Architects members, however, will require additional supporting documentation as listed in item No.4.

4. Entry into the 2012 Dulux Study Tour is a 2 stage process:

Stage 1-To enter, entrants are required submit their answers to 4 nominated questions, their contact details and details of their employer via the online entry system, found at www.dulux.com.au/studytour. Stage 1 submissions must be lodged by no later than **AEST 5pm Wednesday 28th September 2011**. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Entrant's answers to the nominated questions will be judged, and shortlisted entrants will be notified to enter into Stage 2. The judge's decision is final. Refer to section 8.

Stage 2- Shortlisted entrants must upload via the online entry system at www.dulux.com.au/studytour, an A4 document that includes; one written employer reference, resume (maximum two pages), portfolio of works (maximum of four pages) and Submissions for stage 2 must be lodged between **AEST 9am Wednesday 27th October 2011 to AEST 4pm Wednesday 9th November 2011**.

Entrants will be judged on the documentation supplied and 5 winners will be chosen by the nominated jury members. Judges decision is final.

Self nominations must include supporting references from clients or past employers (maximum of three references). The nomination must be uploaded as one pdf document and not exceed 5MB.

5. The Australian Institute of Architects (Institute), Dulux and any additional sponsors reserve the right to publish details of successful applicants (the winners) in all publications

and communications.

6. All submissions will remain the property of the Australian Institute of Architects and will not be returned.

7. The jury will consist of up to seven (7) members including Institute CEO, Institute President, EmAGN President, Dulux representative and other sponsor representatives. The judges' decision is final and the Institute will not provide individual feedback on entries.

8. Five (5) prizes will be awarded for the Study Tour conducted from Monday 12th May to Wednesday 23rd May 2012 (dates are subject to change).

Successful recipients will travel as a group and will need to be available at least two (2) days either side to allow for international travel time. The prize covers domestic transfers, if applicable; return international economy flights, accommodation, transport and an allocation of funds for meals for the duration of the Study Tour program. Each recipient has the opportunity to extend their time at the end of the Study Tour period at their own expense but this must be advised to the Institute at the time of the winners being contacted due to flight arrangements.

9. Winners must have a valid passport at the time of travel otherwise they will forfeit their place on the tour.

10. The five (5) successful winners should be available to attend the Australian Achievement in Architecture Awards on 15th March 2012 in Adelaide, where the recipients will be formally acknowledged. This is not mandatory; the announcement will still be made even if they cannot attend. Travel and accommodation costs will not be provided.

11. The five (5) winners will be required to submit a tour report to the Institute by September 30 2012 as well as present their report at an EmAGN event in their local state.
